- Suggested activity: Construct an agile transformation roadmap addressing organizational roadblocks.
- Suggested activity: Role-play a dependency negotiation scenario between engineering and business leads.
- Suggested activity: Complete a leadership agility diagnostic assessment to outline developmental goals.
